- DALE ROAD PAVING The Supervisors are going to be accepting bids for the paving of Dale Road.
- SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS The Township is having a problem with non-payment of street light and fire hydrant special assessments.

STANDING COMMITTEES

- HIGHWAY SAFETY COMMISSION Supervisor Ron Krise said canopy cutting would be done soon on the trees on Egypt Road. The Supervisors are aware of the sinkhole on Egypt Road and are going to place cones until it can be repaired. They have been fixing potholes on the paved road. They have not done the dirt roads yet.
- EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR Dick Heberling, Emergency Management Coordinator, did not submit a report for the month of February.

CITIZENS INPUT

- DENNIS COBLE JR Dennis asked about Lake Street and Spruce Street paving. The road to the park is bad and the bridge. The Supervisors stated they were trying to get a grant for the bridge for a culvert replacement which was an 80/20 grant and they would see what could be done with the roads. He corner store and what could be done with it. The Supervisors said it is out of the township's hands at this time.
- CHUCK READ Chuck said Lake Street has not been paved in the 20 years he has lived on it. Chuck asked about the Swoope property. He was informed it has been looked into on several occasions and no problems were found.
- MARY BEISH Mary inquired about the tax collector hours. She was advised that the hours are the tax collector's decision not the Supervisors.
- GEORGE FOSTER George expressed his concern as to who enforces building permits in Bradford Township. He was told Pennsafe is the building inspection service the Township uses. He was concerned about someone living in a property on Cotton Lane receiving power and water from an adjacent property. He was also concerned on the sewage. The Supervisors said they would contact Pennsafe and the SEO.
- RICH HEBERLING Rich asked what was being said about Bigler Boyz in regards to Dale Road. He was told there were questions on whether they had bonded the road and were told it had been bonded. Also, complaints were received in regards to speeding but not specifically to Bigler Boyz.

- EASTER EGG HUNT The Township Park and Rec Board is having their annual Easter Egg Hunt at the Woodland Park on Saturday, March, 31st for children ages 0-12.
- COUNTY LIQUID FUEL Bradford Township 2018 County Liquid Fuel allocation is \$5,330.36 which is the same as 2017.
- STATE POLICE Governor Tom Wolf is once again proposing to enact a major issue that would impact Bradford Township. He has proposed a \$25 per capita fee on municipalities that rely exclusively on the State Police for protection. If enacted this would cost the township \$75,850.00 per year based on the population of 3034. PSATS opposes any plan including a per capita fee that would mandate townships to pay for State Police Services. They do support legislation that would allow townships to voluntarily contract with the State Police for patrol and ordinance enforcement services.
- SECRETARY ROUNDTABLE The Township secretary will be attending the Secretaries Roundtable on Wednesday, March 21.
- STATE LIQUID FUEL Bradford Township received \$195,243.22 in State Liquid Fuel for 2018. This is \$9,621.70 more than 2017.
- JAKE RUN BRIDGE The township received a letter from P. Joseph Lehman, Inc. concerning the bridge inspection for bridge T-507 over Jake Run. The bridge inspection is due in March 2018. A list of the recommended repairs and/or improvements from the September 21, 2017 inspection were attached.
- SPRING CONVENTION Moved by Ron Krise and seconded by Ron Maines concerning sending interested officials to the Annual Spring Convention of the Clearfield County Association of Township Officials will be held Friday, May 4, 2018 at the Brady Township Community Center in Luthersburg. The cost will be \$8 per official and \$12 per guest. The Township will pa all expenses incurred. All voted yes.
