HIGHWAY SAFETY  
COMMISSION                              Supervisor Ron Krise said canopy cutting on the trees on Egypt Road was completed. They are going to be sweeping roads in the township. Mutton Hollow has a tree that is going to be cut down. A grant application was submitted to PennDOT for paving the second half of Dale Road for next year. The township is going to try to apply for another DGLVR grant. There is a meeting on Thursday with Rebecca Holler from Conservation for this. We got one grant for Graham Road. A grant application was submitted to have an equipment storage building constructed for all the outside equipment. Some potholes were fixed but the weather caused them to come out. Dirt roads are bad for potholes but the weather is not allowing them to be repaired. There are at least a dozen signs down that will need to be put back up when weather permits. The bridge over Jake Run is going to be looked at for possible funding with DGLVR. Lehman was to get back to the Supervisors with numbers on possibly opening the bridge with weight restrictions but nothing has been heard yet. Bradford Township is on the grant list for the bridge for 2020. The Supervisors are going to talk to government officials and see what they may be able to help with.
