STATE POLICE Fine payment of \$1,792.80 was received from the State Police.

UNITED CONCORDIA Renewal rates from United Concordia for employee dental were received with no increase again this year.

UPMC HEALTH Moved by Ron Krise and seconded by Ron Maines to accept the quote from UPMC for the UPMC Small Business Platinum EPO Plan with a \$471.13 increase per month.

STANDING COMMITTEES

HIGHWAY SAFETY COMMISSION Supervisor Ron Krise said they have been busy grading ditches, the first half of Dale Road has been completed and we got an extra 1000 ft. paved because they did not have to grind. They have been patching holes.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR Dick Heberling, Emergency Management Coordinator, did not submit a report for the month of June.

CITIZENS INPUT

MARY RUPP Mary is requesting a study for jake brake sign on SR322 going west between Walker Road and the barber shop. She said there is also a problem of the third lane being used as a passing lane. The township secretary is to do a letter to PennDOT requesting to have the study done.

ED MOWERY Ed asked if again if there was anything the township could do about the neighbor with loud music. He was advised to contact the magistrate in regards to a private criminal complaint for harassment.

NEW BUSINESS

TAX COLLECTOR EXPENSES Motion was made by Ron Maines and seconded by Ron Krise to pay Tax Collector Pamela Graham's expenses for envelopes and postage in the amount of \$503.14. All voted yes.

TAR AND CHIP BID Motion was made by Ron Krise to accept the bid from Russell Standard for tar and chipping of Egypt Road, Als Road, and Mutton Hollow Road in the amount of \$105,795.80 which was the lowest bid. Former Supervisor Seth Cowder spoke out and said it was stupid to hire out the tar and chipping when the road crew could do it cheaper. They just want to sit in the shop and do nothing. The discussion continued between Supervisor Ron Krise and former supervisor Seth Cowder. Ron said the road crew had more than enough to do and if it were hired out they could do it better as it would be done in one pass and there would be a warranty.

This ordinance will be considered for adoption at the Tuesday August 7, 2018 Board of Supervisors Meeting. All voted yes.
