STANDING COMMITTEES

HIGHWAY SAFETY Supervisor Ron Krise said the road crew has been busy cleaning ditches, berms on roads, repaired hole by fire hall, Dust Clear on McDowell. Still looking for canopy cutting cost, replaced signs, cameras were ordered. The weight limit was reduced on bridge over Jake Run to 3 ton until repairs can be made. We are looking into getting grant money to help with the bridge. We are waiting on decision for grant for low volume road repair.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR Dick Heberling, Emergency Management Coordinator, did not submit a report for the month of September.

VOLUNTEER FIRE RELIEF Bradford Township received \$14,864.30 for the 2017 Commonwealth allocation supporting the Volunteer Fire Relief Association.
