**November 5, 2018**

- PENSION STATE AID                      Bradford Township received \$19,800.83 on September 20th for the 2018 Commonwealth allocation of General Municipal Pension System State Aid. The Township's MMO for 2018 is \$19,315.00.
- STATE LIQUID FUEL                      Bradford Township's estimated Liquid Fuels allocation for 2019 is \$194,946.51. This is an estimated increase of \$2,603.24.
- TRICK OR TREAT                      Moved by Ron Maines and seconded by Ron Krise concerning Trick or Treat night. It was set for Saturday, October 27, 2018 from 4:00 PM – 6:00 PM.
- ORDINANCE 2018-02                      Moved by Ron Krise and seconded by Ron Maines concerning adopting Ordinance 2018-02 for Bradford Township to repeal Ordinance 97-1 which created the Park and Recreation Board.

**HIGHWAY SAFETY

Supervisor Ron Krise has been off so Supervisor Ron Maines said they have been busy cleaning ditches. Ron Krise said he is working on DGLVR grants for Lake Street and Millstone Road. We did not get the PennDOT Multimodal Grant for the paving of the second half of Dale Road so it is to be put out for bid in February. It should be about 50 thousand dollars less than anticipated due to no grinding and less to pave than originally. Ron Krise is meeting with PennDOT on Friday November 9 to go over Hoopup Road for a possible grant on it. ARLE grant if awarded could change to guiderails since the Green Light Go grant was received.
