

**Bradford Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Meeting
November 6, 2017**

CALL TO ORDER The Meeting of the Bradford Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 PM in the Township Office by Chairman William M. Graham.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES Moved by Ron Krise and seconded by Ron Maines to approve the Minutes of the October 3, 2017 Regular Meetings. All voted yes.

TREASURER’S REPORT Moved by Ron Maines and seconded by Ron Krise to approve the Treasurer’s Report as presented. All voted yes.

DISBURSEMENTS Moved by Ron Krise and seconded by Ron Maines to pay disbursements in the amount of \$28,228.65+ since not all invoices are in. All voted yes.

OLD BUSINESS

PENSION STATE AID Bradford Township received \$15,049.73 for 2016 General Municipal Pension System State Aid.

TRICK OR TREAT Moved to setting Saturday October 28, 2017 from 4 PM – 6 PM for Trick or Treat in Bradford Township.

BRIDGE INSPECTION A letter was received from P. Joseph Lehman, Inc. concerning the bridge inspection for T-507 over Jake Run. A list of the recommended repairs and/or improvements from the inspection were attached. The weight limit was reduced to 3 ton and the Supervisors are checking on different possibilities.

LIQUID FUELS Bradford Township’s estimated Liquid Fuels allocation for 2018 is \$192,343.27. This is an estimated increase of \$6,721.75.

PURTA Bradford Township received \$586.38 for the 2017 distribution for the Public Utility Realty Tax for the tax year 2016.

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- VOLUNTEER FIRE RELIEF Bradford Township received \$14,864.30 for the 2017 Commonwealth allocation supporting the Volunteer Fire Relief Association.
- GRAHAM SUBDIVISION Moved by Ron Maines and seconded by Ron Krise to approving the Preliminary/Final Plan Maps submitted for Maynard C. Jr. & Michelle L. Graham Subdivision.
- GRAHAM SUBDIVISION Moved by Ron Maines and seconded by Ron Krise to approving signing the Component 1 submitted for Maynard C. Jr. & Michelle L. Graham.
- UNEMPLOYMENT The taxable wage base for Unemployment Compensation will increase from \$9,750 to \$10,000 for 2018.
- PENNDOT PennDOT has announced of road closing set for October 16 – 18 on a section of Shiloh Road. They will be replacing a 48-inch cross pipe. A detour will be in effect directing drivers on alternate routes to use.

STANDING COMMITTEES

- HIGHWAY SAFETY Supervisor Ron Krise said the road crew has been busy doing ditches and berms on roads. Still looking for canopy cutting cost, camera for Doe Hill Road was ordered. Decision was made and Bradford Township was awarded grant for low volume road repair on Graham Road.
- EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR Dick Heberling, Emergency Management Coordinator, did not submit a report for the month of October.

CITIZENS INPUT

- CHUCK READ Chuck Read mentioned the berms being done in Woodland.

NEW BUSINESS

- ILLEGAL DUMPING Bradford Township received illegal dumping complaints for the month of August from Clearfield County Solid Waste Authority Enforcement Officer Chuck Haines.
- SECRETARY ROUNDTABLE The township secretary attended the Secretary’s Roundtable on October 18, 2017 at the Goshen Township Building.
- GREEN LIGHT GO Bradford Township submitted an application to the Green Light Go Program. If accepted it would be to update the signalized intersection at SR 970, Doe Hill Road, and Owens Road.

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- MATSON INSURANCE Matson Insurance Agency is now handling all township and BJW Fire Company insurance which has resulted in a savings of approximately \$8,575.00 overall.
- ANNUAL BUDGET Moved by Ron Maines and seconded by Ron Krise to approving the 2018 Proposed Annual Budget with Final Adoption at the December 5th Board of Supervisors Meeting
- ANNUAL BUDGET Moved by Ron Maines and seconded by Ron Krise to advertising the 2018 Proposed Annual Budget for 20-day inspection period.
- MIDLAND ASPHALT Moved by Ron Maines and seconded by Ron Krise to approving the Major Modification/Land Development Plans submitted for Midland Asphalt Materials, Inc. contingent upon the Planning Commission Approval.
- NEXT MEETING This month's second meeting will be held Tuesday, November 21st at 4:01 pm if needed.
- ADJOURNMENT Moved by Ron Krise and seconded by Ron Maines to adjourn the meeting. All voted yes.
