ANNUAL BUDGET Moved by Ron Krise and seconded by Ron Maines to approving the 2019 Proposed Annual Budget with Final Adoption at the December 4<sup>th</sup> Board of Supervisors Meeting.

ANNUAL BUDGET Moved by Ron Krise and seconded by Ron Maines to advertising the 2019 Proposed Annual Budget for 20-day inspection period.

ASSESSED VALUATION Bradford Township's estimated assessed real estate valuation for 2019 is \$25,678,681.00. This is a decrease of \$101,211.00 from 2018.

**STANDING COMMITTEES**

HIGHWAY SAFETY COMMISSION Supervisor Ron Krise said the road crew has been busy replacing stop signs and weight limit signs. They placed the No Parking sign on Knepp Road. He said there were two grants submitted for the DGLVR grants for Lake Street and Millstone Road. He said the grant for DCED Multimodal was postponed until sometime in December. Dale Road second half may be put out for bid in February. It should be about 50 thousand dollars less than anticipated due to no grinding and less to pave than originally. Ron said they were going to put in for tree trimming on Dale Road before paving. The Supervisors need to check with Terry Forcey on some trees. They may put in for more cutting on Egypt Road. Ron said the smaller the grant amounts the more likely we will get. The washouts on Egypt Road were fixed.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR Dick Heberling, Emergency Management Coordinator, did not submit a report for the month of November.

**CITIZENS INPUT**

JIM ENGLISH Jim said RJ Corman has still done nothing with the road. His concern is if the road freezes. It was mentioned about cutting a ditch but was not sure that would work. The supervisors along with Jim were going to contact another representative from RJ Corman to see if the issue could get resolved.

DAVE GLASS Dave introduced himself to the supervisors and said he would be running for commissioner.

ARTIE BAUGHMAN Artie asked if the dip in Egypt Road could be repaired. The supervisors said they would work on getting it fixed.
