- AUDITOR REPORT** Sally Morgan gave the report from the auditors on the township and they were pleased with the way the supervisors are trying to save the township money and applying for the grants and being consciences.
- BIGLER YMCA** Moved to donate \$6,500. 00 to the Bigler YMCA which is the same amount as 2021 after Alex Weaver spoke about the Summer Playground Program.
- NITTANY MINIT MART** Moved to grant an additional variance to Nittany Minit Mart on their rear lot of three feet.
- SMALL FLOW PUMPING** Williams & Sons Services, Inc. who does the pumping of the Small Flow Systems sent a letter that they had to raise the pumping fee from \$225.00 to \$245.00 per 1000-gallon tank due to rising costs. This increase went into effective March 1, 2022.
- PENNDOT LETTER** A letter was received from PennDOT in regards to the resident request for a mirror on Gross Road. Permission could not be granted for the mirror according to Strike-Off Letter 494-16-10. PennDOT can

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investigate the possible placement of a dashed edge-line on SR 1012 at the stop location to help motorists identify the edge of the through route.

PENNDOT MULTIMODAL

Bradford Township was awarded \$706,188.00 from PennDOT Multimodal Grant for the Egypt Road Bridge Project.
