DOC WELKER PAVING Moved to advertise to accept bids for the Doc Welker Road Paving Project which is part of a grant the township received to be awarded at the August 2, 2022 monthly meeting.

ACT 13 PAYMENT Bradford Township received \$11,096.62 for 2021 Act 13 Reporting Year. This is \$4,565.94 more than 2020 Reporting Year.

DCED MULTIMODAL The grant application was submitted for the DCED Multimodal Grant For Hoopup Road.

ARLE GRANT The grant application was submitted for the ARLE Grant for guiderail on Dale Road.

HIGHWAY SAFETY COMMISSION Supervisor Denny Mulhollan said they have been hauling a lot of dirt. The grants they received for Wilson and Long Run Roads are complete. Hoopup Road is 90% complete with tree trimming to be completed later

GP-8 PERMIT E-FORESTRY Bradford Township received a letter from E-Forestry that they applied for a temporary stream-crossing permit (GP-8) with Clearfield County Conservation District. The project is located ½ mile west of Woodland off Pinetop Road. The purpose is for timber management.

WORK CAMP A donation was received from the Work Camp for the use of the Woodland Park for the week of their work camp.
