



**BRADFORD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULAR MEETING**

**November 1, 2022**

- PLANNING COMMISSION Moved to re-appointing William Elensky and Ronald L. Krise to the Bradford Township Planning Commission. Their four-year terms would expire September 5, 2026.
- LONG SUBDIVISION Moved to approve signing the Preliminary/Final Maps submitted for the Gary Long Subdivision.
- PENSION STATE AID Bradford Township received \$13,795.48 on September 28th for the 2022 Commonwealth General Municipal Pension System State Aid allocation. The Township's MMO for 2022 is \$15,526.00.
- ESTIMATED LIQUID FUELS Bradford Township's estimated Liquid Fuels allocation for 2023 is \$179,161.99. This is an estimated increase of \$1,066.26 from last year.
- PURTA DISTRIBUTION Bradford Township received PURTA Distribution check for tax year 2021 in the amount of \$615.63.

**STANDING COMMITTEES**

- HIGHWAY SAFETY COMMISSION Supervisor Denny Mulhollan said there was paving done in the township. He said Grahampton, Forcey, and Doc Welker were paved. PA American had Burkett's Addition paved because of waterline replacement. Berming was still needed. Hoopup crossover pipe areas were fixed. Ron Krise said about grants that had been submitted and grants to be submitted. He said about the canopy cutting needing done on Doc Welker Road.
- EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR Justin Millinder, Emergency Management Coordinator, did not submit a report for the month of October.

- DENNY PETERS Denny mentioned about the concern on fuel. The supervisors said they were definitely concerned on the cost of fuel.
